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





resolving of the thing out of preexisting matter, the later means bringing into being without matter by uttering the simple command 'Be'.

"We should choose people on the basis of experience, training and knowledge; how to do the job, and on character. That's the ideal person we want, one who has both good character and know-how..."






Imam W.D. Mohammed on "the **Principles..."**

 - Reflects the pattern in human nature (Fitrah)
 - An entire surah named for this principle
 - 42:38-Revealed in Mecca

In Human Nature

- Human Development Continuum
