Restrictive law

Restrictive Laws of Islam

This means all believers must strictly obey these laws. Mere belief counts for nothing unless carried into practice.


- Obey Allah, His Apostle and believe the Message He has sent to you and me by His Messenger.
- Obedience to the Apostle is obedience to Allah, as the Messenger is the bearer of Allah's Message. Respect to the Messenger is respect to Allah.
- Worship no God but Allah. The one the Messenger represents to us.
- 4. Fear no one but Allah.
- Obey those in authority among you and obey nonbelievers in authority over you as long as it does not conflict with your religion.
- 6. It is forbidden to commit fornication or adultery.
- It is forbidden to commit indecent acts on another (sodomy).
- 8. It is forbidden to eat the pig or it's by-products.
- Honor Allah and respect His Messenger, who is the bearer of His Message to you and me.
- 10. Insubordination is forbidden.
- 11. Slack talk and gossip is forbidden.
- Do not associate with those in bad standings or out of the mosque.
- It is your duty to report all slackness, weakness and wrongdoing.
- Do not deal with the hypocrites or show sympathy towards them.
- No gambling of any kind (numbers, dice, cards, games of chance)
- No smoking of any kind (reefers or cigarettes, cigar or pipe).
- 17. No dope (heroine, cocaine or any other).






Salma Slims black female rapper



On being a female rapper with immigrant muslim parents: "I am Muslim myself so being Muslim alone in the United States has brought hardship. My last name is "Conteh" so I get a lot of questions already. The media portrays Muslims as terrorists, however the religion itself practices peace. Every race and religion has bad guys, and not all of us are the bad guys. Some people judge me because they think I'm not actually from a certain "hood" and they like to call my bluff and say "you're from Africa you're not even from Atlanta" then a lot of other people think that because we pray five times a day, that I shouldn't even be a rapper, and that's why it took so long for my family to accept the music because modesty has nothing to do with rapping. It gets frustrating sometimes because people are gonna say what they want."




Q-Tip

Shahada, <u>changed</u> his name from Jonathan Davis to Kamaal Ibn John Fareed.


He's <u>practiced</u> the faith ever since. "I think everyone should just be allowed to believe what they want to believe, as long as they don't transgress against the next person,"

he told the Guardian. "It doesn't make a difference what you are. I read the Quran and it appealed to me. At the time I was agnostic and it really breathed spiritually back into me. For me it's really a cushion, it's cool, I'm cool with it."

Rappers Muneera Williams and Sukina Owen-Douglas make up the London-based hip-hop duo Poetic Pilgrimage. According to *Huffington* Post, the women met during college and both converted to Islam after learning of *The Autobiography of* Malcolm X in class. Their goal as rappers is to show that Islam and Western culture aren't incompatible, and that women have a place both in rap and as outspoken members of the Muslim community. They wear hijabs onstage, and have met their fair share of criticism, but that doesn't stop them from making music.



Hip-hop legend and actor Mos Def, also known as Yasiin Bey, was introduced to Islam at 13 by his father, who was a member of the Nation of Islam. At 19, Mos Def <u>took</u> his Shahada, or declaration of faith, and in the '90s debuted as an artist in the socially conscious movement hip-hop that emerged then. Many of his albums and live performances begin with the Islamic prayer, "Bismillah ar-Rahman ar-Raheem," or, "In the name of God, the most gracious, the most merciful."






